Carbon Reduction Plan

ClearView Ultrasound Service Ltd

1. Commitment to Achieving Net Zero

ClearView Ultrasound Ltd is committed to achieving **Net Zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050**, in line with UK Government targets.

2. Baseline Emissions Footprint

Our baseline year is 2024, when we first measured our carbon footprint.

Baseline Emissions (tCO₂e):

- Scope 1: Direct: 0.8 tCO₂e (minimal use of gas heating and negligible fuel use, as staff commute in low-emission vehicles).
- Scope 2: Indirect Energy: purchased electricity: 1.0 tCO₂e (electricity for 120 m² premises, prior to switching to renewable supply).
- Scope 3: Other Indirect: purchased goods, commuting, waste, logistics: 4.2 tCO₂e (small shipments, limited travel, supply chain inputs).

Total Baseline: 6.0 tCO2e.

3. Current Emissions Reporting

For the reporting year 2024/25, our emissions are recorded in the baseline above.

4. Emissions Reduction Targets

ClearView Ultrasound Ltd has set the following interim targets:

- > 50% reduction by 2030 (from 6.0 tCO₂e to ~3.0 tCO₂e)
- > 75% reduction by 2040 (~1.5 tCO₂e)
- Net Zero by 2050.

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Carbon Reduction Plan (cont.)

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5. Carbon Reduction Projects

Measures implemented since baseline year:

- > Introduced digital-first operations to reduce paper and travel.
- Improved waste management and recycling of packaging and electronic components.

Future measures planned:

- ➤ Encourage electric vehicle (EV) commuting and install charging point in 2025.
- > Switch to 100% renewable electricity supply in 2026.
- > Full transition to hybrid/electric company vehicles by 2027.
- > Further reduction in shipping emissions through consolidated deliveries.
- Ongoing supplier engagement to ensure lower-carbon packaging and materials.
- > Explore installation of solar photovoltaic (PV) cells on premises by 2030.
- Consider certified carbon offsetting for any unavoidable emissions.
